The Tree of Promises offers a range of smaller value prizes in fixed denominations: £10, £20, £30, £40 and £50 which are hidden at random in envelopes. Live Auction

The auctioneer will read out a Lot Number and a short description of the corresponding Lot. If you wish to bid, clearly raise your personal bidding number to face the auctioneer. Your bidding number will be given to you upon arrival. The auctioneer will note your bid and your bidding will continue until a final bid is reached, at which point the auctioneer will confirm the winning bid number.

We are thrilled to have Claude Piening, a senior specialist at Sotheby's, conducting our auction. Claude has been at Sotheby's for over twenty years and is Head of the 19th Century European Paintings and Orientalist Art Department. Whilst we don't have masterpieces from his category in the sale tonight, we welcome and appreciate Claude's expertise to guide us through the evening.

How and when to pay

If you are successful in your bid, a host will come to your table and hand you a Buyers Contract, which details your winning Lot.
