
What is FOFW?

Doctors and nurses will come and do talks to the children, there will be toy drives where the Head Boys and Girls can take the donations to the hospital and possibly even a visit from an ambulance to the playground!

We are also going to develop a series of **Parent Talks** inviting speakers in to talk to us about important topics like Cyber Safety, Gender Diversity, Paediatric First Aid, Positive Parenting, Nutrition and more. We are very open to ideas so please let us know what you would like to hear about.











Focus for 2017/2018

It's not just about the fundraising. We are building a flourishing community. Floreat is a small school with 210 pupils. **Everyone can make a difference – this is OUR school.**

FOFW meet with the teachers, the executive, the head, we talk to parents, other PTA's, the kids and we develop a 'Wish List' of things that will help our children and our school thrive. These items range from the really big to the really small.

> The 'big item' this year is an amazing, colourful, modular, outdoor play area. It will cater to all ages.

Our target in 2015 was £10,000, our target in 2016 was £25,000 and our target in our 2017/2018 is £40,000.

Last year we were asked for a minibus. We developed a proposal for the Floreat Board and we all agreed that we should wait until the school is bigger before investing in a mini bus.
