

Vhat is my child learning about at school? Inction: Macbeth our child will be learning to retell a model text based upon Shakespeare's <i>Macbeth</i> . They ill be using this as a stimulus to examine and compose a character flaw tale that also incorporates elements of suspense. The children will recap upon story structures, as well as determining what makes a story successful. We will recap sentence structures including different types of relative clauses, as well as using a range of speech and also wodal verbs which indicate degrees of possibility.
