CO-OP GRANT

We are very excited to announce that Friends of Floreat Wandsworth has been selected by the Co-Op as a charity that Co-Op members can support as part of the Local Community Fund for the next year! That means that anyone doing their shopping in the Co-Op can be set up to give the school a 2p kick back for every £1 spent.
